CAPITAL LETTERS	____ Did you capitalize? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> the title's first, last, and important words <input type="checkbox"/> the <i>first word in a sentence</i> <input type="checkbox"/> the <i>pronoun I</i> <input type="checkbox"/> <i>proper nouns</i>

APOSTROPHE USE	____ Did you use an apostrophe to form <i>contractions</i> and <i>possessives</i> ?
